- 1.1. Important to get good links eg. AWM in Canberra
- 1.2. SA at War
- 1.3. DVA support
- 1.4. Library of South Australia
- 1.5. South Australia War Memorial
- 1.6. Contact archivist at RAH (Need to establish contact details)

## Discussion

- 1.7 The committee wanted to focus the website purely on South Australia until up and running successfully then it can be expanded as required.
- 1.8 It was noted that the RAAMC did not officially occur until 1948. Prior to that it was the AAMC.
- 1.9 Sven Kuusk drew the committees attention to the Bibliography of Australian Military History (and ANU paperwork).
- 1.10 It contains all published and many non published manuscripts especially on unit histories.
- 1.11 Metals and awards to include QHS and QHP post nominals.
- 1.12 Patterson at PAOCA now has 5000 bibliographic summaries.
- 1.13 Alterations to the website menu
  - 1.14 Alter allied services to read Allied Health Services
  - 1.15 Add Role of Honour
  - 1.16 Add POW
  - 1.17 Add Voluntary Aid Detachments
  - 1.18 Add Medical Australian Army Women's Services
  - 1.19 Add Philanthropic Organisations eg.
    - 1.20 Red Cross
    - 1.21 Salvation Army
    - 1.22 Red Triangle

These changes will be added to the website menu for further discussion and approval at the meeting on 13th February 2007

- 2. Company Funding Sources
  - 2.1. Medical supply companies a good source of funds
  - 2.2. Army Medical and Veterinary Stores another source of funds.
- 3. Australian History Unit Grant
  - 3.1. Sven Kuusk briefed the meeting on the requirements for Australian History unit Grants.
    - 3.1.1. Two assessors
    - 3.1.2. Assess on points (need 80 to qualify)
    - 3.1.3. Usually given to publish a book

- 3.1.4. Already been published by Tyquin
- 3.2. It was decided that to be successful the grant application would need to:
  - 3.2.1. Refocus on the deficiencies in the Tyquin book
  - 3.2.2. Get the advice of the head of unit Roger Lee
  - 3.2.3. Remember that they want all corps histories done in the immediate future.
- 3.3. It was decided to apply when the committee is ready but not in Feb 2007.
- 3.4. The committee should aim to apply in say Feb 2008 if possible.

## 4. Department of Veteran Affairs Grants

- 4.1. Sven Kuusk briefed the meeting on the requirements for Veterans Affairs Grants.
- 4.2. Remember that they are commemorative grants
  - 4.2.1. Grants are to create but not to administer
  - 4.2.2. Must be able to demonstrate the long term administrative viability of the use of the grant (i.e. Must have demonstrated funding for outgoing maintenance).
  - 4.2.3. Most grants are for about \$3000.00 and special case must be established for larger grants.
  - 4.2.4. Remember the purpose of the target audience is to clearly **educate** public, veterans and school children.
  - 4.2.5. Focus on unit history and individual RAAMC histories.
  - 4.2.6. The new federal minister Bilson is very supportive.

- 4.4. It was decided to apply in the near future, to fund the website.
- 4.5. Emphasis needs to be placed on the community benefit flowing from such a grant.

## 5. Simpson and Donkey Statue Project

- 5.1. The committee was updated on the proposed Simpson and the Donkey Statue.
- 5.2. It was noted that the committee may be asked to provide assistance at a future date.
- 5.3. The committee agreed with the chairman's view that the original sponsors should continue to run with the project.
